Applications are invited from the eligible students from Backward Classes communities for appearing for Bank Pos and Clerks . The selected candidates will be sponsored to Reputedempanelled coaching Institutes in the State for providing professional guidance for Bank Examination.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:

Banking And Other Eligible Examinations Coaching

I. Bank Probationary Officers, Specialist officers and Insurance officers exams – A total of Rs 20,000 (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) which will be towards –

- ... Financial Assistance would be provided towards coaching fees up to Rs 12,000 (Rupees Twelve Thousand only) which will be credited directly to the institute's account.
- ... Financial Assistance towards books, stationary, boarding and lodging expenses - Rs 8,000 (Rupees Eight Thousand only) which will be credited to the beneficiary's account as a onetime grant. This will be credited on furnishing of the course completion certificate.

II. Bank Clerks, Regional Rural Bank Exams and Staff Selection Commission exams – Rs 15,000 (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only) which will be towards –

- ... Financial Assistance would be provided for training with coaching fees up to Rs 7,000 (Rupees Seven Thousand only) which will be credited directly to the institute's account.
- ... Financial Assistance towards books, stationary, boarding and lodging expenses - Rs 8,000 (Rupees Eight Thousand only) which will be credited to the beneficiary's account as a onetime grant. This will be credited on furnishing of the course completion certificate.

III. Course duration for the Bank POs and Clerks is 3 to 6 months.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. The applicant should belong to Backward Classes of Andhra Pradesh.
2. The annual family income shall not exceed Rs. 6.00 lakhs
3. Age: Eligibility for examination shall be as per Bank Notification guidelines.

Age criteria**Bank PO's**

1. Candidates He / She had minimum age 21 years maximum age 30 years as on 01-08-2017.
2. OBC Candidates have 5 years relaxation.
3. For Disabled Candidates have 5 years relaxation
4. The applicant should not have availed himself or herself of any amount under any other Government scheme for the same purpose.

Educational Qualification: Candidate should have passed any Degree course.

Bank Clerk's

1. Candidates He / She had minimum age 21 years maximum age 30 years as on 01-08-2017.
2. OBC Candidates have 3 years relaxation.
3. Ex-Servicemen / Disabled Students have 5 years / 8 Years, subject to maximum age of 50 years.
4. The applicant should not have availed himself or herself of any amount under any other Government scheme for the same purpose.

Educational Qualification: Candidate should have passed any Degree course.

IBPS PO Exam Pattern & Syllabus 2017: Changes Up-to-date

[IBPS](#) conducts a common written exam(CWE) to appoint staff in 19 public sector banks. In this article.

IBPS PO Exam (VI) Pattern 2017

According to latest notification IBPS PO/MT Exam 2016 will be conducted online. There are total two stages i.e. Preliminary Exam & Main Exam.

IBPS PO Preliminary Examination

The preliminary examination contain *three papers* having total of 100 marks. The total duration of the preliminary exam is of **1 hour**.

English Language – 30 Questions – 30 Marks
Quantitative Aptitude – 35 Questions – 30 Marks
Reasoning Ability – 35 Questions – 35 Marks

IBPS PO Main Examination

The IBPS PO/MT main examination contain five subjects having total 200 marks. The total duration of the main exam is of 2 hours.

Reasoning – 50 Questions – 50 Marks
English – 40 Questions – 40 Marks
Quantitative Aptitude – 50 Questions – 50 Marks
General Awareness – 40 Questions – 40 Marks
Computer Knowledge – 20 Questions – 20 Marks

Negative Marks: The penalty of 0.25 marks will be levied, if any wrong answer has been given. The candidates are advised that they must ensure about the correct answer while marking the answer. In other case if candidate does not attempt the question and left black it, no wrong penalty will be applicable.

Minimum Cut Off Marks: The candidates must score a minimum marks or score in each of the paper to apply for the vacancies in [participating banks](#). The minimum cut off marks will be 24 (Gen. Category) and 21 (for reserved category).

Interview: After getting the position in the list of shortlist of the candidates for IBPS PO/MT main exam the candidates will be called for the interview. The total marks for interview are 100. The marks should not be less than 40% to qualify the interview. The weightage ration of CWE Exam and interview should be 80:20.

IBPS PO Exam Syllabus 2017

Test of English Language

In this, test will be based on student's capability to understand the English like as vocabulary, comprehension, general usage, grammar, and error detection. Vocabulary means Antonyms/synonyms/completion sentence. Comprehension means theme detection/completion passage/find the conclusion. Grammar means indirect direct speech/active passive voice. Error detection means passage/sentence/spelling correction.

Test of Logical Reasoning

Logical reasoning has two types one is verbal and second one is non-verbal. Verbal reasoning means blood relation/sitting arrangement/judgement/statement/coding decoding/making series and syllogism. Non-verbal means making series/analogy and classification.

Test of Quantitative Aptitude

Quantitative aptitude means play with numbers and calculation like as add/minus/multiple/average/roots/percentage/profit & loss/ratio/time & distance/stock & shares/area. Data interpretation is also one of the parts of quantitative aptitude, in this tabulation/graphs like as bar/line and charts will be asked as questions.

Test of General Awareness

Meaning of general awareness is the ability to be conscious of events and current affairs of India like as sports/constitution/technique/economics/science/politics/culture and banking.

Test of Computer Knowledge

Computer has divided into two parts. One is hardware and other software. Hardware means bodily parts of computer like as monitor/printer/mouse/keyboard/C.P.U and, etc. Software means application like as Ms office/paint/coral draw and, etc.

IBPS Clerk Exam Syllabus 2016-2017 – Pre & Main – Latest UptoDate

The IBPS Clerk Exam 2017 is a good opportunity for candidates who wish to make an easy entrance into the Government Job sector. This exam is one of those exams where candidates can easily score good marks and begin a prosperous career. However, it is important for a person to understand the basic structure of the exam, so that he/ she can proceed accordingly.

Two-Tier Exam Pattern

The IBPS Clerk Exam 2017 has been segregated into two tier system where a preliminary level exam is conducted followed by the main examination. A candidate has to first appear in the preliminary level and after crossing the first stage, the candidate will have to sit for the main examination. The basic intent of hosting this pattern is to eliminate the non-serious candidates.

IBPS Clerk Preliminary Examination Syllabus

The Preliminary Examination is the first step towards the IBPS Clerk Exam. The exam is extremely simple and tests the potential of a candidate at a very basic level. The duration of the exam is 60 minutes / 1 hour and includes questions on English Language, Reasoning and Numerical ability. An expanded note on this exam is given below:

A candidate is required to answer maximum number of questions correctly within a time frame of 60 minutes. This will be an online examination, hence, the window will automatically close after 60 minutes.

Main Examination

The candidates who have cleared the preliminary level will sit for the main examination. This exam is comparatively tougher and more encompassing. Students will require to show their brilliance here. The pattern of this examination is given below:

So, as one can see, the exam includes more chapters and more questions. Hence, the examination has duration of 120 minutes/ 2 hours. Candidates who have successfully cleared the exam will be called upon for the interview round.

Negative Marking for wrong answers

Preliminary and Main examination, both, will have negative markings. If a candidate has answered a question incorrectly, then 0.25 will be deducted from this overall score.

Nevertheless, there is no negative marking or deduction where a question has been left unattended.

IBPS Clerk Main Exam Syllabus 2016-2017

The IBPS Clerk Examination 2016 has setup a two-tier system for scanning the best candidates from the country. The first examination is named as the Preliminary examination with a maximum score of 100 and the second examination is named as the Main Examination with a maximum score of 200. Candidates who have successfully cleared the Preliminary examination are eligible for Main examination. Negative marking applies to both examinations and will cost the candidate 0.25 for every wrong answer. Candidates who have cleared both the examinations will go to the next round, where the interview will be conducted.

First Section – Test of Reasoning

First section will be Logical Reasoning means the process of forming judgments, conclusions from premises or facts. The question in this section may be based on Verbal and Non-Verbal. **Verbal** means classification, analogy, decision making, word formation, series, decoding & coding, blood relation, symbol & notation, statement & conclusion, sitting arrangement and problem solving. **Non-Verbal** means series completion, finding any missing figure and classification.

Second Section – English Language

Second section of 'IBPS exams 2016-2017 Syllabus for clerks CWE' is English language. It is one of the most important languages because it is wider and useful in all over the world, so the managing committee wants to select only those candidates who are capable of understand English. The questions in this section may be asked from the topic is vocabulary means homonyms, synonyms, antonyms, sentence completion, word formation and the topic comprehension means deriving conclusion, theme detection, passage completion and the topic Rearrangement of passage, spelling, sentence and the topic grammar means set of rules active passive voice, indirect direct speech and the topic General usage means phrases and idioms.

Third Section – Numerical Ability, Quantitative Aptitude

Third section of 'IBPS Exams Syllabus for clerks CWE' is Quantitative Aptitude in this question will have five multiple-choice answers. The question in this selection may be based on two topics like as Arithmetic and Data Interpretation. Data Interpretation means bar graphs, pie charts, line graphs and tabulation. Arithmetic means roots, average, ratio, time & work, time & distance, percentage, profit & loss, mixture, stocks & shares, partnership, clocks, volume & surface area, height & distances, logarithms, permutation & combination, simple & compound interest, in equations & equations and probability.

Fourth Section – General Awareness

Fourth section for IBPS common test is General Awareness. These questions are not based on any specific study but related to current affairs. Definition of the current affairs is recent activity of India, and its neighbor countries like as sports, constitution, politics, history, banking, culture, geography, economy, techniques and Finance.

Fifth Section – Computer Knowledge, Computer Awareness

Last section of “IBPS exams 2017 Syllabus for clerks CWE” will be computer awareness means knowledge and ability to use computers. Questions are based on two topics like as hardware and software. The topics will be covered in this section are MS Office, MS Word, MS Excel, MS Power Point, Windows, internet and how to operate well for official use. You can say that just basic knowledge of computers. The previous questions papers contains the following topics operating systems, computer networks, internet, E-commerce, the basic computer architecture, terminology, EFT systems, acronyms and MS Office 2003, 2007 power point.

NUMBER OF SEATS AVAILABLE FOR THE COACHING PROGRAMME:

- 2000 candidates for Bank Pos and 2000 for Bank Clerks from Backward Classes communities (A,B,D Groups) will be selected sponsored to the Reputed Empanelled Institutes.
- 1000 Candidates EBC for Bank Po’s and 1000 Candidates EBC for Bank Clerks.
- 33% of the awards shall be earmarked for Women candidates (if adequate number of eligible women candidates are not available then Male candidates may be selected against this 33%).
- 4% of the awards shall be earmarked for Specially Abled Candidates (if adequate numbers of eligible Specially Abled candidates are not available then other eligible candidates may be selected against this 4%).
- A waiting list of 10% of total number of candidates will be maintained.
- The provisionally selected candidates including waitlisted candidates original certificates will be verified by the BC Welfare Department before declaring final select list.
- If the candidates fails to produce the original certificates or if they are found ineligible as per the guidelines of the scheme, during certificates verification process, their provisional selection will be cancelled.
