NOTIFICATION

Applications are invited from the eligible ST, SC & BC Candidates of Telangana State for Screening Test to select the candidates for Integrated Guidance Scheme for UPSC Civil Service Examination 2019 for Prelims cum Mains cum personality test. The selected candidates will be provided the guidance scheme for (9) months in residential mode at IAS Study Circle for STs at Manasa Hills, Rajendra Nagar, Hyderabad.

ELIGIBILITY:

- **Age:** A candidate must have attained the age of 21 years and must not have attained the age of 37 years for ST and SC and 35 years for BCs and 42 years for PHC as on 1st August, 2018.
- **Educational Qualification:** Candidates should have passed graduation in any Discipline recognized by the Universities.
- **Already Aailed candidates not eligible:** The candidates who have already aailed coaching for Civil Services at any Government study circle (SC, BC) or taken the coaching at any private Study Circles with financial assistance from the Govt. are not eligible to apply.
- **Income Ceiling:** Annual family income should not exceed Rs.2.00 lakhs

HOW TO APPLY:

Eligible ST,SC & BC candidates who wish to apply have to submit their applications through ONLINE mode only by login into studycircle.cgg.gov.in/tstw

SCREENING TEST: (Objective, Descriptive and Aptitude (Personality Test)

Screening test will be conducted for applied candidates.

- **Venue:** Dr.Br.Ambedkar Open University Campus (Prof.G.Ram Reddy Marg, Road No:46, Masthan Nagar, CBI Colony, Jubilee Hill, Hyderabad, Telangana 500033)
- **Date and Time:** probably on 12.08.2018 (Exact Time and Date will be intimated through the website)

SELECTION: The candidates who secures 50% and above marks in screening test (Both Objective and Descriptive) will be called for aptitude test (Interview). Basing on the consolidated merit (Both Screening test and Interview) candidates will be selected.

SYLLABUS : Syllabus for the screening test is annexed

PATTERN OF SCREENING TEST:

The pattern of screening test will be intimated through the Website.

NEGATIVE MARKS: There will be 1/3 Negative Marks in Objective type test.

HALL TICKET TO BE DOWNLOADED:

Hall Tickets can be downloaded by the students one week before the Screening Test from the website of Dr.BR Ambedkar Open University, Hyderabad. (www.braou.ac.in)

NUMBER OF SEATS AVAILABLE FOR THE COACHING PRGRAM:

100 ST,SC & BC candidates of Telangana State will be selected through Screening Test (Objective, Descriptive and Aptitude (Personality) Test) will be provided the guidance scheme for (9) months in Residential Mode at IAS Study Circle for STs at Manasa Hills, Rajendra Nagar.

RESERVATION:

- **75% to ST Candidates (ST seats will be distributed among all sub – groups of STs as per their population, so as to ensure equity among sub groups, additional weightage will be given to PvTGs)**
- **15% to SC Candidates**

- 10% to BC Candidates(A, B, C, D, E categories)
- 33 1/3 % for Female candidates in overall seats
- 3% for disabled (PH) candidates as per norms.

FOR RENEWALS: From the students who have taken Civils coaching at IAS Study Circle for STs, Rajendranagar, during 2017-18, (20) meritorious Students will be provided opportunity for coaching in 2018-19 batch. The selection criteria will be communicated personally to the candidates shortly, they need not apply for screening test.

Submission of online application : Starts from 05.07.2018 ends on 04.08.2018
